BGGC CADET GLIDING SCHOLARSHIP 2019 **TERMS OF APPLICATION/SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Applicants must be aged between 14-16 years old on the 1st April 2019.
2. Applicants are ideally expected to dedicate at least one full day (9.00-17.30) each weekend and at least one weekday during school holidays to training and club activities. The BGGC understands training can correspond with a busy and important time in the academic year and are flexible, however failure to attend without notification or good reason could result in the termination of the scholarship.
3. All applicants are to abide to all rules and regulations, policies, procedures and code of conduct set out by Bristol and Gloucestershire Gliding club (please see website www.bggc.co.uk/members/committee for details).
4. Parents able to certify medical fitness of applicant (to the equivalent of DVLA Group 1 standard).
5. Applicants must weigh between 52kg – 102kg due to glider limitations, for solo flight.
6. A short list of applicants will be selected for interview in February and asked to deliver a presentation (approx 10 mins) which demonstrates their interest in aviation and an understanding of gliding in particular. Interviews will be held on 2³rd March 2019. Applicants will be notified of the outcome during the following week. Successful applicants will begin their training with an induction day the following weekend 9/10th March 2019 (subject to weather).
