Safety Information for Trial Lessons & Visitors

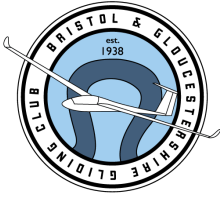
1. For Safety reasons we cannot fly anyone who is over 16 stone or 6'6" in height. You must also be physically able to get into and out of the glider with minimal assistance (this is roughly the same as getting into or out of a bathtub). Please call us if in any doubt.
2. Visitors are not permitted beyond the Clubhouse, Car Park or Garden areas unless accompanied by a Club Member. You will be escorted to and from the glider for your first flight.
3. Do not walk or drive in front of any aircraft or glider. Please be vigilant at all times particularly when crossing the field. The whole of the airfield is used for landings - from all directions. Aircraft that are committed to land may be unable to avoid you! Please refer to attached map.
4. Please keep children under close supervision and dogs on a lead at all times.
5. Do not approach the propellers of powered aircraft, even when engines are switched off.
6. Visitors are not permitted to use any of the Club's mechanical equipment under any circumstances.
7. Smoking is not permitted in the vicinity of aircraft and in all Club buildings.
8. Please remain behind the launch point vehicle while at the launch point.
9. Your vehicle is probably not insured on the airfield, driving on the airfield is at your own risk.

General Information for Trial Lessons

1. We will try to arrange the flight at your specified time but the nature of our sport does require a little flexibility!
2. Please retain your voucher if you would like to take additional training flights within your temporary period of temporary membership. Additional flights may be taken at club member rates
3. If you have any questions about any aspect of gliding – please ask!
4. If you wish to return and make use of your membership to fly again, please contact the office to obtain a copy of 'Notes for New Members'. Read these notes carefully and make sure you understand the safety notes before venturing onto the airfield unaccompanied.

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Declaration for Trial Lessons & Visitors

In consideration of my being admitted as a member of the Bristol & Gloucestershire Gliding Club ("the Club") and of my being afforded the Club facilities for gliding and gliding instruction, I agree to be bound by the Operational Regulations of the Club and the British Gliding Association. (Trial Lessons Only)

I have informed the Club of any medical condition, which could cause a problem with the flight (e.g. blackouts from any cause, epilepsy, severe head injury, recurrent fainting or giddiness, high blood pressure, angina, coronary artery disease, diabetes etc.). If in doubt please consult your GP.

I confirm that I do not weigh over 16 stone and I am under 6'6". I confirm I have not consumed alcohol within the last 8 hours.

I understand my safety and the safety of others may be affected by my behaviour on the airfield. I have read and understood the safety information above and will behave responsibly and in accordance with instructions while on the airfield. All visitors accompanying me have also read and signed a copy of this safety briefing.

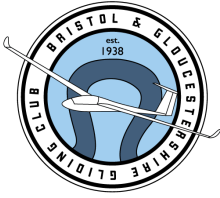
