Prior to the Accommodation being used it will be cleaned. Once the person has left the accommodation will be cleaned again. A Record of the cleaning and those occupying the accommodation is kept for contact tracing purposes.	Whilst within the Communal Areas of the clubhouse face masks must be worn. Hands Sanitization should take place a regular intervals. To protect the staff cleaner a period of 3 days should elapse between the accommodation being vacated and staff cleaner cleaning the accommodation. 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Catching COVID 19 from using facilities after another person who has the virus	Clubhouse Toilets and showers	Club Members, Staff and Residents	All Club members are asked to take lateral flow test prior to attending the club to reduce the risk of bringing the infection on site.	Instructions and Signage. First Person at the beginning of EACH day cleans the facilities with the relevant equipment and signs the sheet. When inside face masks will be worn. Windows and Doors will be left open to provide as much ventilation as possible.	Club Members, Staff and Residents
Catching COVID 19 from using facilities after another person who has the virus	Club house Kitchen and communal areas.	Club Members, Staff and Residents	Occupancy of the members' kitchen should be restricted to one person at a time and users should thoroughly clean utensils and surfaces before and after use with hot water, soap and/or disinfectant wipes and put items used away after use.	Members should remain in small groups and wear face coverings indoors. Social Distancing should be maintained throughout. Communal Areas are cleaned on a regular basis and should be	Club Members, Staff and Residents
